

Family Information for the 170th Irish Picnic July 27th & 28th, 2024

The Irish Picnic is the major fundraiser for Saint Patrick School and this year marks the 170th year for the annual event.

Family Picnic Obligations:

- ⊗ **Every family is required to work the Picnic for both days. It is hard to put a minimum amount of hours per family for an event of this magnitude. We need everyone to be heroically generous for its success. The success of your booth is the measure of your commitment. Every family must cover the hours in their booth set by the booth chair. And then see who else needs help.**
- ⊗ Booth assignments will be sent out the first week of June. If you have any questions please call the office. (931)582-3493.
- ⊗ Bring to the school two dressed barbie dolls, action figures, cars, or trucks for the Doll Booth.
- ⊗ Provide an auction item or basket—deliver to the school by July 25
- ⊗ Sell 25 tickets for the prize drawing booth.
 - ⊗ \$1 donation per ticket is suggested. Turn the ticket money or unsold tickets into the school or parish office, St. Patrick's church collection baskets, or at the prize drawing booth at the picnic. For extra tickets or questions, please call School office (931)-582-3493
- ⊗ Attend one work day to get the picnic grounds ready for the event. Each work day begins at 9am: **Saturdays, June 29th, July 6th, 13^h, or 20th**
- ⊗ All families need to assist the Chair of their booth with any repairs, painting, etc. in preparation for the Picnic in addition to a work day. All booths chair are responsible for painting and repairing their booth.

- ⊗ Bring the food for Dinner Stand on the Saturday of the picnic. Please do not bring your food on Friday except...
 - Families with Last Names beginning with A-G, please bring your 3 cakes to the **cake booth** on **Friday Night**.
 - Families with Last Names beginning with H-Z, please bring your 3 cakes to the **dinner stand** on **Saturday**—please do not bring them on Friday.
 - Note: a request has been made for cakes to come in a disposable cake pan with a lid. Regardless, keep the cake fresh and sealed.

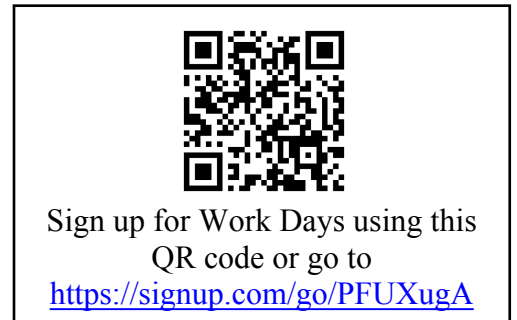
